

Instructions for Daily Radiation Treatment

Treatments

Your daily radiation treatments will be scheduled Monday through Friday for the length of time specified by your doctor. The time of day will be scheduled when you report for simulation. It is important that you arrive at the specified appointment time so that your treatment can be completed as efficiently as possible. If you need to reschedule your treatment time on one or more days, please speak directly to the therapist at the appropriate treatment machine.

Doctor Visits

You will have mandatory visits with your doctor while you are undergoing radiation treatment. This doctor visit is a very important part of your medical management. Your doctor will monitor your progress, evaluate and treat any problems and approve continuation of the treatments. You will see your doctor on a “first come, first serve basis.” If you are unable to come for your weekly appointment, please notify your nurse or doctor. Your treatments may be stopped if you do not come for these appointments.

Please be sure to check the list that is posted on the board in the dressing room for the day your doctor’s visit will take place.

Parking

To receive free parking at MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper, 2 Cooper Plaza, in Camden, patients must:

- Have a scheduled outpatient simulation, radiation treatment or brachytherapy related procedure that day.
- Use valet parking.

Free parking is available at MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper in Voorhees and at the MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper CyberKnife Center.
